

SIX GREAT BASEMENT IDEAS

1. Utilize recessed areas with bookshelves, desks and closets.
2. Use knee walls to divide rooms and allow light to flow.
3. Install sconces in the stairwell – a classy way to bring in light.
4. Utilize stairwells with recessed shelves or kids' playhouses.
5. Use lofts to maximize storage areas.
6. Install tile at the entrance-way to keep carpets cleaner.
